Activity Report of NSOU-Bidhannagar College Learners' Support Centre

The Memorandum of Understanding MoU was signed between Netaji Subhas Open University and Bidhannagar College on 27th December 2022 for successful running of the PG Personal Contact Programme in Zoology. Bidhannagar College Learners' Support Centre-LSC or (or Study Centre) (Centre Code: I-09) of Netaji Subhas Open University (NSOU) for the Personal Contact Programme (PCP) has been established at the Department of Zoology of Bidhannagar College in the year 2007. The course conducted in this study centre is the Post Graduate Degree Programme in Zoology (PGZO) for two years.

The admission process in this course is centralized and conducted by NSOU itself based on merit and counselling. Faculty members (University approved) from different Government Colleges, Government-aided Colleges, and Universities are addressing PG classes regularly on every Sundays and also on Saturday and holidays (if possible). The total student intake capacity in this LSC for PG Zoology is 25 per year. It imparts quality educations through ODL mode.

PG Classes are scheduled all throughout the year as per the routine provided by the university. Registration, renewal of studentship, form fill-up of examination and publication of results are carried out online and conducted by the University itself. Study materials are made available to the students in both printed and online formats. So that students can download it from university website if not possible to collect physically. Apart from the offline classes university also engages online special classes for students of all the LSCs.

Bidhannagar College Learners Support Centre (LSC) provides different logistics and infrastructural facilities, academic and research support to the learners for their academic and professional development. Present student strength of the LSC is 25 per batch.

Theory exam is conducted by the university in other colleges apart from respective LSCs but practical exam is run by the respective study centres. Students have to clear in each group for a particular paper. Both assignments and term end examination are compulsory to qualify the exam. Every year students need to renew their studentship through university



online portal. NSOU have engaged students through NSOU app and website information along with intimation to the coordinators. University regularly visits and gets updates regarding the progression of the students and the study centre.

Practical work for both part-1 and part-2 is conducted in the study centre by respective faculty members. Students are encouraged to do project work for their post graduate dissertation or thesis on any related matters or topics. Many students have presented their research work in different national and international seminar. Few of them have completed or pursuing PhD work from different universities. Few students have published their dissertation work in scientific book chapter.

Faculty members of different institutions take classes of PGZO programme. They also help students to complete their assignments and dissertation work. Teachers also encourages students to participate in summer internship programme.
