2. A poster competition was organized by NSS volunteers and students on the occasion of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav on 8th August 2022.
3. National Librarian Day was celebrated on the occasion of the 130th birthday of Padma Shri Dr. S. R. Ranganathan organized by IQAC and Central Library, Bidhannagar College.
