NSS was established in 1969 with a vision of personality development of students through community service. NSS Unit has been introduced in colleges with an objective of building a sense of social responsibility amongst students, acquire leadership qualities and practice national integration and social harmony. Special camping is an integral part of NSS and it has special appeal to the youth as it provide unique opportunity to the students for group activities, collective experience sharing and constant interaction with the community.
