ACTIVITY NO. 1

Independence Day Celebration (15.08.18)

Bidhannagar College was all set to observe the 72nd independence day of India on 15th August 2018. Everyone on the campus was geared up & enthusiastic for the momentous occasion. Dr. Soumyasree Sen, Head, Department of Education hoisted the National flag as Officer-in-Charge of this College and delivered speech on the importance of the day. Dr. Supriya Chatterjee, Programme Officer of the NSS unit delivered speech relating that day and the motto of NSS. Three songs were sung by NSS volunteers and a drama performed by Students' Union. 74 students, 9 teachers and 2 non-teaching staff were present in the programme.

ACTIVITY NO. 2

College cleaning programme

Bidhannagar College NSS unit has a vision and strong commitment towards the service of the society. The said unit is always involved with the activities related to cleaning of campus and awareness programmes on different issues on societal life among students.

(a) First day of campus cleaning on 22.09.2018:

In pursuit of control of vector borne diseases and preventive measures against Dengue and Chikunguniya, the following steps have been taken. College organized a campus cleaning programme at its premises where NSS volunteers (divided in several groups) carried out a massive cleanliness drive. The waste material such as plastic and paper cups, papers, plastic and paper packets were collected from the campus lawn. Sprinkling of bleaching powder and phenyl were done over the open drains of the campus.

21 volunteers and 4 teachers were present in the cleaning programme.

(b) Second day of campus cleaning on 14.03.2019:

The same work as stated in (a) had been done by the students. 8 volunteers and 2 teachers were present in the cleaning programme.

(c) Third day of campus cleaning on 26.03.2019:

After a few days again a thorough campus cleaning, sprinkling of bleaching powder and phenyl on different spaces of the campus lawn were done. Beside this, leaflets on control and preventive measures of vector borne diseases, Dengue and Chikunguniya were also distributed among students for their awareness. The leaflets were also distributed to the general public outside the College.

Water samples were collected from different sources of campus lawn and examined by the faculty of Zoology Department. It was found that more than 70 percent of mosquito larvae were of Aedes aegypti.

Moreover a request letter was sent to Bidhannagar Municipal Corporation to take necessary control measure for the same before commencement of the classes after long vacation because the campus of the College is too large to take any preventive and control activity for the same by volunteers of NSS unit.

ACTIVITY NO. 3

Observation of NSS day on 24.09.2018

The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of Bidhannagar College marked the NSS Day by the introductory lecture by Dr. Madhumita Manna, Principal of this College. The guests from Debesh Dutta Memorial Trust spoke about the donation of eye and body after death. The programme officer delivered a speech on objective and activity of NSS. Forty-nine volunteers, 7 teachers and 7 guests were present and observed the NSS day.
