The West Bengal State Aids Prevention and Control Society, Swasthya Bhavan, GN -29, sector-V, Salt Lake, Kolkata-91 took part in this Program . Mrs. Sumita Samanta, Assistant Director, West Bengal State Aids Prevention and Control Society, attended the Program with her group members in this awareness Program. Mrs. Samanta delivered a lecture on AIDS and its prevention through power point presentation. Mrs. Samanta discussed elaborately about the disease AIDS and how the same can be prevented. She emphasized on public awareness to grow about the disease and the students can play a very great role in forming this awareness among common people.
